## **For children coming in to school as of Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020**

Thank you for responding swiftly to the recent letter regarding childcare provision at the school. Your child has a place in our school. We know the list of key workers may change over time and we will share any information with you when we have it.

The following measures/precautions must be taken to support this arrangement:

- Children wear clothes which are fresh on – we recommend putting clothes straight in the washing machine once returning home from school to minimise and control the spread of infection. We will continue with our regular hand washing routine at school. For your information we have drafted a weekly timetable today - the children will do a variety of activities over the week at school which may include outside learning, PE and art. Please wear appropriate clothes/footwear for these activities and always bring a coat.
- Please ensure we have up to date contact details for family members and we hold emergency contact details should your child become poorly/exhibit symptoms of contracting coronavirus.
- We must register your child in and out of the premises by somebody who either has parental responsibility or has been nominated by yourselves. As usual we cannot let children go home with other adults without being informed – even if we know them/they are other parents.
- If you become unwell with coronavirus symptoms, you must **immediately** contact school and arrange for the collection of your child.
- Social distancing **must** be enforced whilst your child is not in school if we are to prevent/minimise the spread of infection.
- School **must** be informed if you no longer fall within the critical worker list or you have been asked to self-isolate.

I am sorry for the lateness of these details – there is a lag in information still.
