

Dear parents and carers,

New advice was put in place yesterday evening in relation to coronavirus: people with 'new and persistent coughs' should self-isolate for 7 days.

We called the education helpline to clarify the meaning of 'new' before the start of school today. As a result of the advice given, we have asked Miss Child in Class 2 to self-isolate at home for seven days as she has a cough. We will arrange class 2 cover to minimise disruption to you.
