

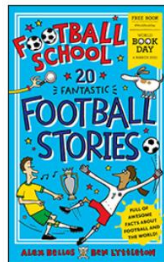
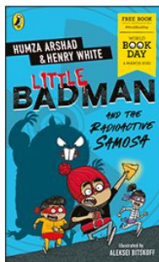
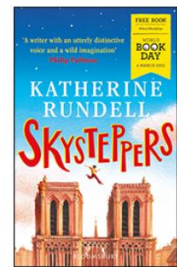
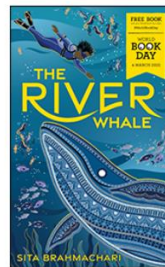
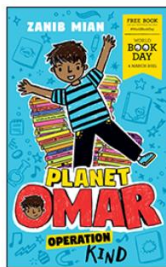
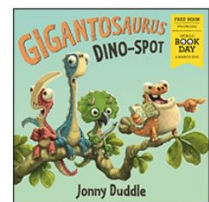
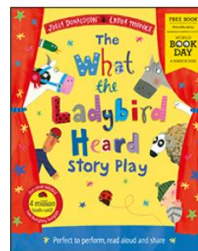
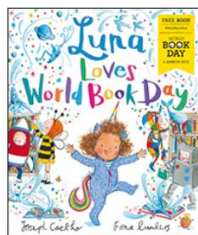
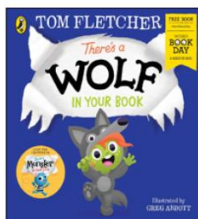


## World Book Day - update
