Terms 3 & 4

The topics that we will be covering during this term of 'Europe – France' are:

English	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Stories from other cultures● Poetry with different forms e.g Shape, Calligrams, Haikus, Cinquains● Persuasive writing● Diary writing● Weekly spelling test on a Wednesday with a new list given on a Thursday for homework.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Multiplication and division● Length, perimeter and area● Fractions and decimals● We will also work on our four operations – one session per week to practise regularly column addition and subtraction etc. Times Tables Rock Stars will also continue and 25/50 club each week.
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Light – how we see things. Understanding reflection and danger of sunlight in our eyes. How shadows are formed and how they can change● Setting up enquiries, making a fair test, testing results and writing conclusions● Plants – how water is transported within plants, labelling parts of a plant, finding out about pollination. Understanding seed dispersal.
Computing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Communication – text, images and multimedia.● Edit digital content for pictures and text. Design a powerpoint presentation.
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Name and locate counties and cities of the UK. Find geographical regions and human characteristics including hills, mountains, cities and rivers● Identify the equator● Study a region of France exploring similarities and differences with the UK and within France itself.
Art / DT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Art – study of artist: Pablo Picasso. Focus on drawing experimenting with different grades of pencil to create lines and marks. Experiment with tone and show attention to detail.● DT – materials including textiles.●
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Dance● Tag Rugby with a sports coach – Mr Meloscia
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● What does it mean to be Hindu in Britain today?● Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Listening to music by Bach. Understanding instrumentation and appreciating the style.● Exploring music by Randy Newman for Disney. Listening and researching about this genre.
PSHE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Five school values and five ways of wellbeing● Rights and responsibilities
