Dear parents,

As a school we teach children to use computing technology well and safely. We know this is an area that all children need strong knowledge in to enable themselves to keep safe as they use technology in and outside school. Our PSHE and Computing curriculum cover aspects of safety and we offer the children other opportunities too with Y4 enjoying Into the Net play and Y6 children working with our local BEAT Officer PC Weedon.

On the 8th February it was Safer Internet Day. PC Weedon and the Schoolbeat team, have produced two short videos of tips to stay safe online. One is to support children and one is to support parents. They discuss gaming etc and offer top tips for children and parents. Having looked at them, the video for children looks like it is aimed at children in KS2/Upper KS2 and older.

Please enjoy watching them before you share with your children so you are happy with the content and are prepared for the questions that might be raised by your child when watching together. Talking together about internet safety is important – children are learning and will make mistakes so keeping the conversation open will help them learn to keep safe in the long term.
