



Covid-19 information for all parents

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be working with the children in school. Your children are wonderful, and we are enjoying learning together.

As a school we have 13 PCR/LFT confirmed cases in total – 1 case in Class 1, 1 case in Class 2, 8 cases in Class 4, 1 case in Class 5, an adult in Class 4 and an adult in Class 5.

As a result of the increase in cases we will move to working in semi-bubbles. This means children will not mix inside unless necessary. During lunch, when children have to be inside together to eat, children will sit in their class groups with a gap between them and other classes – the hall will be well ventilated. Assemblies will move online. We will continue to ventilate classrooms, undertake additional cleaning of frequently touched areas at lunch time and support good hygiene through regular hand washing/hand sanitising.

Arrangements will remain the same for picking up and dropping off children.
